


Access To Education For All

RELEVANCE TO INDIAN ARMY EX -SERVICEMEN

The Uttarakhand is a prouder state where from a large number of soldiers in the armed forces. Garwal regiment and kumaon regiment are well known for their velour & sacrifices. It is also a strategic state located along China border. The border areas are under developed not only in physical infra structure but also in the Higher Educational field.

Developing facilities for higher education in border and hilly area is a big challenge but we are motivated by the incentives given by the Govt. of Uttarakhand to facilitate the entry of private sector in higher education.

This is also in line with the thinking process of our higher management of our Trust, which is mainly Defence oriented.

Welfare of Ex. Servicemen

The welfare of Ex servicemen in terms of higher education is our priority area of concern. There are large number of ex-servicemen, who are settled in various parts of Uttarakhand and in Chamoli district itself from the reliable sources it is gathered, there are approx 6500 serving personnel and approx 15500 ex-servicemen. There is similar concentration in other parts of Uttarakhand as well.

These men joined armed force after 10+2 and retired in the prime of their age after 15 to 17 years of service in the Army, Navy and Air Force. Though they are well experienced, capable & fulfill the job requirement but are not able to achieve their aspirations for second career as they are deprived due to lack of academic qualifications.

For instance - A solider retiring after 15 years of service though considered equalent to graduate for his army education But denied group 'A' & 'B' posts through SSC due to non- reorganization equivalent to civil qualifications. One such example is given below.

Clarification about Educational Qualification of Ex-Servicemen Candidates

Railway Board clarification about the Educational Qualification of Ex-servicemen for post of Senior Section Engineer – Diploma with endorsement in the same as equivalent to Engineering degree is not a valid Certificate

For instance: A soldier retiring after 15 to `17 year of service is considered equivalent to graduate only for clerical post in the bank or other civil jobs But for higher posts he is not considered graduate for the obvious reason. This is intriguing; therefore, there is a urgent need for providing higher education as per UGC norms and make the academic qualification to full fill their aspiration for a civil career.

This shall be a major step to development of Human resource in the border areas of the State.

Beside Ex. Servicemen, the civilian population in the area is also deprived of such employment opportunities due to lack of facilities of higher education. Therefore our ambition is to bridge this gap and nurture the talent to bring prosperity and Human resource development in the border areas of the State.
